Dalmatian Club of America Scholarship Award

The DCA will offer one or more \$500 scholarships each year in which the DCA Junior Showmanship Committee feels there is a qualified and deserving applicant. No scholarship must be awarded if the DCA Junior Showmanship Committee does not feel that there is a qualified and deserving applicant. (If there should be more than one deserving applicant, the DCA Board of Governors will decide if more than one scholarship can be provided that given year.)

Scholarship criteria

- 1) The scholarship will be open to both twelfth grade students graduating from high school and students already enrolled in college.
- 2) Applicants must have been DCA members for at least two years.
- The college or university must be accredited institution of higher learning (2-4 year school).
- 4) The high school aged applicant must have a grade point average of 3.2 or higher upon graduation (eighth semester). The college-aged applicant must carry a current grade point average of 3.0.

Application process

The applicant must complete and return three (3) copies of the application and supporting documentation.

- 1) An official complete four-year transcript from the high school, showing the grade point average and class rank. The college student must supply a currently college transcript to date.
- 2) A letter of recommendation written by a member of DCA who is not the student's family member.
- 3) A personal essay that describes the student's experience with DCA and the Dalmatian, as well as plans for future involvement with the breed.
- 4) A past recipient of the scholarship may reapply for consideration in subsequent years.

Selection Committee

The president of the DCA and the members of the DCA Junior Showmanship Committee will serve as Selection Committee for scholarship. Their decision will be final and will be supported by the Board of Governors. Should the Selection Committee wish to support a second candidate that it finds worth, such a recommendation will be made to the Board, which will then ratify the decision of the committee. Members of the Selection Committee cannot write recommendations for scholarship applicants.

Deadline for applications: Applications must be received by the Chairman of the DCA Junior Showmanship Committee on June 1st of each year. Postmarks will not be considered.

Notification: July 15th of each year. The DCA Treasurer will then mail the stipend to the student's college registrar to be applied to the student's tuition account. It is the recipient's responsibility to notify the Treasurer of the exact access and references to accomplish this transfer. This notification must be made prior to the beginning of the fall semester of the year of the award.

Report Back to JS Committee: If an individual accepts this scholarship, it is strictly understood on January 1st of the following year the award of the scholarship, each recipient will provide a report detailing how the scholarship stipend has been used and the effect that the award has had toward their education. The report should be 400 words and cite specifics.
