Entry Fee

\$25.00 per entry per dog per test <u>Closing date is March 30, 2022, at 6:00pm EST</u> (Includes \$3.50 AKC recording fee) Overnight or certified mail must be sent with the "No Signature Required" waiver signed. <u>Incomplete, unsigned, or conditional entries will not be accepted.</u>

Entries after March 30th will be charged the Day of fee of \$30 per entry. Day of entries as space allows with secretary permission.

RETURNED CHECKS: DRMarketing will not return checks for entries that are not accepted or cancelled by the competitor before the closing date and before the check has been deposited. We shred all unused checks. All entries must be accompanied with payment to be valid. A Returned Check for insufficient funds will be charged an additional \$30 fee & is not a valid entry.

This will be a CONCURRRENT Trial using a BLOCK schedule. NO RUN ORDER! A time block will be assigned. An email explaining the process will be sent out prior to the trial.

Fast CAT events are open to all dogs at least 12 months of age that are registered with the AKC, dogs granted a Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL) number, dogs with limited or Conditional Registration and dogs enrolled in the Canine Partners program. Dogs with breed disqualifications and monorchid/cryptorchid dogs are eligible to participate. If your mix breed dog needs an AKC Canine Partner number a form and information is available on page 5 in this Premium. Dogs may only run once per test.

Hours

Grounds will be available a half hour prior to trial hours. Trial hours are usually 8:00AM until 3:30PM or until all runs are completed.

It is also the responsibility of entrant to be ready with catcher and releaser when their dog is called to the line.

<u>Collar Rules:</u> Dogs may run without a collar or wear any type of collar except choker collars, electronic training collars or head collar. Collars should be snug. Hanging tags pose a safety concern and it is suggested that tags be secured to the collar with tape. Dogs may run muzzled if desired. Clips or rubber bands may be used for long hair from falling across the dog's field of vision.

Check in & Inspection.

Check in/Inspection starts 15 minutes prior to the beginning of the trial and each time block or throughout the event. Every dog must pass through inspection before each run. Dogs who miss their time block will be skipped. If you do not check in within one hour prior to the end of the trial closing, we will assume you are absent. No refunds for absent dogs. At inspection, all dogs will be examined for disqualifications. Bitches known to be in season are not to be brought to the test. At inspection, bitches in season, lame and unfit dogs will be excused with entry refunded minus a \$5.00 service fee per run.

Refunds!

You may pull out of the trial prior to closing date/time for a refund minus a \$5.00 service fee per entry run per dog. There will be no refund after closing for any reason, including injury or illness to human or dog of any kind, unless the limit has been met and there is a waitlist participant to take your spot.

Prizes

A flat blue ribbon for a passing qualifying run.

Rosettes for completing titles BCAT, DCAT or FCAT, as available.

Please notify the Trial Secretary in advance if you anticipate completing a title by writing in on the bottom of the entry form.

What is the Fast CAT?

- 1. Fast CAT is a timed straight 100-yard dash for dogs.
- 2. Dogs are held at the start line and the coursing lure is activated prompting the dog to follow chasing it to the finish line and into a catch pen. The course is completely fenced, and dogs are run individually.
- 3. Dogs are timed when they complete the 100-yard dash. The time is converted to Miles Per Hour (MPH).
- 4. Based on the dog's size at the withers a handicap is applied. and points are earned:
 - 18" or greater = Handicap is 1.0
 - 12" up to less than 18" = Handicap is 1.5.
 - Under 12" = Handicap is 2.0.

5. FORMULA: MPH X HANDICAP = POINTS

6. Titles are earned at specific point levels.

BCAT = 150 points, DCAT = 500 points, FCAT = 1,000 points

FCAT# = Each additional 500 points

*ACCORDING TO AKC RULES; Handlers are not permitted to run with a dog during an official run. Handlers are not to entice the dog through the course with anything other than the lure during its official run. NO mechanical devices including whistles, horns, bull horns, etc. Or toys including the waving of objects to lure the dog to the finish line. You MAY CHEER and use the dog's name only.

Trial Information

- Dogs should be warmed up before and cooled down after running.
- ALL DOGS RUN AT OWNER'S SOLE RISK
- All entries must be 12 months of age or older on the day of the test.
- All AKC rules regarding sportsmanship and conduct apply.
- This is a rain-or-shine outdoor event. Please plan accordingly.
- An electric and electronic timing system will be used.
- The show grounds are not completely fenced. The FAST CAT course will be fenced.
- On site bathrooms are available.
- Dogs must be on lead or crated unless running.
- A fine will be assessed for any loose dog on the field not competing, or an exhibitor caught not picking up after their dog.
- You are responsible for controlling your dog(s) and children.
- Each dog requires an individual entry form for each event in which it is entered.
- Bitches in season and lame dogs will be excused. **Entry fees will be refunded** minus a service fee of \$5.00
- •The Hunt master is responsible for field safety and therefore he/she is in complete charge of all dogs and handlers on the field. He/She has the authority to stop the lure in any potentially dangerous situation and signal the handler to retrieve the dog on the course.
- Persons exhibiting conduct detrimental to the AKC/DCA
 / Dog(s) or person(s) will be asked to leave the trial site by the Field Committee, may be disciplined by the AKC, and entry fees will not be refunded.
- No entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot be started or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club.
