EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

Certification: A written statement must accompany each TD entry for any dog that has not previously passed an American Kennel Club TD or TDU Tracking Test. The statement must be dated within two years of the date the test is to be held, signed by a person approved by the AKC to judge Tracking Tests or by a person/evaluator who has handled a dog to a TDX or VST title within the last ten (10) years, and must certify that the dog has satisfactorily performed a certification test.

Entry limitations: The Tracking Dog Test will be limited to 4 dogs and the Tracking Dog Excellent Test will be limited to 3 dogs. If the limit for entries is not reached in one test and the limit is exceeded in the other test, the number of tracks will be exchanged up to the limit set by the AKC Tracking Regulations. If the limit is not reached in Dalmatians, other breeds may enter using the following procedure: Draw (1) Dalmatians without a TD Title, Draw (2) Dalmatians with a TD Title, Draw (3) Other breeds without a TD Title. Draw (4) Other breeds with a TD Title.

Dogs must be six months of age or older.

Entries must be on an official AKC entry form & will not be accepted without fees & signature & a statement of certification, if applicable.

Drawing of Entries for TD/TDX Test: A drawing will be held at 7:00 pm on April 19, 2023 at the home of the Test Secretary. The drawing shall be completely random among all Dalmatian entries received without a title followed by Dalmatians with a Title. Any remaining tracks will be filled by other breeds (including All Americans) without a title followed by other breeds (including All Americans) with a title in accordance with Chapter 1, Section 17b of the Tracking Regulations. When the limits have been drawn for all Dalmatian TD, all remaining entries shall be assigned to a position on an alternate list corresponding to the

order in which they were drawn. Should the limits not be reached for the TD or TDX test, tracks may be exchanged on a basis of two TD tracks equal one TDX track. The Test Secretary will notify all entrants of the results of the draw by email within 24 hours after the draw. Upon notification, alternates shall have the option of accepting or refusing the opportunity to be placed on the alternate list. **Please include your email address!**

Drawing for Tracks: The Judges will assemble the participants at the Champoeg RV Group Campsite Building for the drawing by lot of the track number of each participant. The time for the draw will be stated in the Judging Program which will be emailed to the participants. The order in which tracks are run and the number of each track shall be determined by the Tracking Judges. Entrants & alternates must be present at this drawing to guarantee their position in the test. The first track for each event will be run as soon thereafter as it has aged the proper length of Time. In the event of absentees among the confirmed entries, the next alternate, in drawing order who is present, will be allowed to fill the vacancy.

Refunds: No entry fee will be refunded, except the entry fee of a non-participating alternate. Or in the event an accepted entry cancels after the closing date & the Secretary is able to replace the entry from the alternate list. The entry fees will be refunded within seven days following the Test.

Bitches in season: Tracking Regulations Chapter 2, Section 8. Bitches in season may participate. The Test Secretary & judges are to be notified prior to the drawing for running order the day of the test. The last track(s) to be laid shall be reserved for the bitch(es) in season. If there is more than one bitch in season, a second draw for these bitches will be held.

The show-giving club, the Test Secretary, the landowners and the park assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by spectators, exhibitors, handlers or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

No dogs allowed in rest rooms & no washing of animal food containers in rest rooms. Exercise dogs in designated areas only.

No videotaping or photography during the events for resale is permitted without Dalmatian Club of America. Inc. approval.

Please be advised: When exhibitors/handlers bring a dog to the podium for a win/placement photo, they are establishing a de facto contract with the show photographer to purchase that photo.

All AKC Rules & Regulations will be enforced by the Show Event Committee under AKC guidelines. Failure to comply with these rules will result in charges being brought before the Show Event Committee. Any event hearing, disciplinary action, rule violations, complaints or charges will be resolved by the Dalmatian Club of America, Inc. National Specialty Event Committee. The Show Event Committee members are Nadine Morgan, Kathy Mulej, Corinne James, Marti Nickoli, Becky Richardson.

DOGS RUNNING FREE In accordance with AKC Tracking regulations, Chapter 1, Section 21, Due to the changing nature of the fields being used by clubs for tracking tests and the increased population at these sites by the general public, dogs must be "on lead" at all times on any area of the tracking site. This will not apply to dogs owned or under the control of individuals not associated with the tracking test.

The show-giving club assumes no responsibility for the welfare of children & further expects exhibitors & spectators to keep their children under strict control.

Unless otherwise specified, all trophies must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed, except for those trophies that have been specified herein.

Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendents/Secretaries will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging areas.

The Club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. Fees must be paid in guaranteed funds. The Secretary will add a \$35 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

Owners are responsible for errors in filling out entry forms; no refund for duplicate entries or errors on entry blanks.

Entry Fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the Secretary.

No entry shall be made, and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

Changes, Additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

EXHIBITORS NOTE: Please notify Secretary of any change of address. Telephone Entries and Unsigned Entries Cannot Be Accepted. Entries Not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. Emailed acknowledgement of entries will be provided IF an email address is included.

The eligible events are: Road Trial – CC, RD, RDX classes; Tracking – TD or TDX; Agility – all titling classes; Obedience – all titling classes; Rally – all titling classes; Barn Hunt – all titling classes; Scent Work – all titling classes; and FAST CATS. Only one score or performance in each venue will count towards this award, and the performance must be at the titling level, although the dog/handler team may already have earned the relevant title. If your dog can hock, heel, sniff, run, or jump, just pick your venues and go for the challenge!
