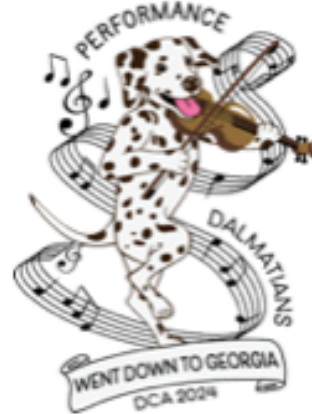

Performance Award- The Triathlete Challenge



If you and your dog are a multi-tasking team, set your sights on the SPECIALTY TRIATHLETE CHALLENGE. A special award given to EACH Dalmatian/handler team that earns a qualifying leg or passing score in three (3) or more performance/companion venues during the National Specialty. The eligible events are: Agility - all titling classes; Barn Hunt - all titling Classes; Fast CAT; Obedience - all titling classes; Rally - all titling Classes; Scent Work - all titling Classes; Road Trial - CC, RD, RDX classes; Tracking TD. Only one score or performance in each venue will count towards this award, and the performance must be at the titling level, although the dog/handler team may already have earned the relevant title. If your dog can hock, heel, sniff, run, or jump, just pick your venues and go for the challenge!

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

- **Certification:** A written statement must accompany each TD entry for any dog that has not previously passed an American Kennel Club TD Test. The statement must be dated within two years of the date the test is to be held, signed by a person approved by the AKC to judge Tracking Tests or by a person/evaluator who has handled a dog to a TDX or VST title within the last ten (10) years, and must certify that the dog has satisfactorily performed a certification test.
- **Entry Limitations:** The Tracking Dog Test will be limited to **6 dogs**. If the limit is not reached in Dalmatians, other breeds may enter using the following procedure: Draw (1) Dalmatians without a TD Title, Draw (2) Dalmatians with a TD Title, Draw (3) Other breeds without a TD Title, Draw (4) Other breeds with a TD Title.
- Dog must be six months of age or older.
- Entries must be on an official AKC entry form & will not be accepted without fees & signature & a statement of certification, if applicable.
- **Drawing of Entries for TD Test:** A drawing will be held at 7:00 PM on **May 15, 2024**. At the home of the Test Secretary. The drawing shall be completely random among all Dalmatian entries received without a title followed by Dalmatians with a title. Any remaining tracks will be filled by other breeds (including All Americans) without a title followed by other breeds (including All Americans) with a title in accordance with Chapter 1, Section 17b of the Tracking Regulations. When the limits have been drawn for all TD's, all remaining entries shall be assigned to a position on an alternate list corresponding to the order in which they were drawn. The Test Secretary will notify all entrants of the results of the draw by email within 24 hours after the draw. Upon notification, alternates shall have the option of refusing the opportunity to be placed on the alternate list. **Please include your email address!**
- **Drawing for Tracks:** The Judges will assemble the participants at the Georgia National Fairgrounds RV Campsite for the drawing by lot of the track number of each participant. The time for the draw will be stated in the Judging Program which will be emailed to the participants. The order in which tracks are run and the number of each track shall be determined by the Tracking Judges. Entrants & alternates must be present at this drawing to guarantee their position in the test. The first track for each event will be run as soon thereafter as it has aged the proper length of Time. In the event of absentees among the confirmed entries, the next alternate, in drawing order who is present, will be allowed to fill the vacancy.

We don't want to step in your dog's poop!

Be responsible and clean up after your dog.
By signing the entry form for this test, you agree to pick up after your own dog. It is actually a bench show offense to walk off without picking up.





- **Refunds:** No entry fee will be refunded, except the entry fee of a non-participating alternate. Or in the event an accepted entry cancels after the closing date & the Secretary is able to replace the entry from the alternate list. The entry fees will be refunded within seven days following the test.
- **Returned Checks** do not constitute a valid entry fee. Fees must be paid in guaranteed funds. The Secretary will add a \$35 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY BASIS.
- **Bitches in season:** Tracking Regulations Chapter 2, Section 8. Bitches in season may participate. The Test Secretary & Judges are to be notified prior to the drawing for running order the day of the test. The last track(s) to be laid shall be reserved for the bitch(es) in season. If there is more than one bitch in season, a second draw for these bitches will be held.
- No dogs allowed in rest rooms & no washing of animal food containers in rest rooms. Exercise dogs in designated areas and PLEASE pick up YOUR dog's poop.
- **All AKC Rules & Regulations will be enforced by the Show Event Committee under AKC guidelines. Failure to comply with these rules will result in charges being brought before the Show Event Committee. Any event hearing disciplinary action, rules violations, complaints or charges will be resolved by the Dalmatian Club of America, Inc. National Specialty Event Committee; John Cramer, Dr. Kelly Flannigan, Toni Linstedt, Karen Rowan & Michele Wrath.**
- Please Note: Any hotel or motel listed in the premium list is subject to Event Committee Rules. We expect our exhibitors to be responsible guests. A report that an exhibitor at this show has abused hotel or motel property during this week/weekend may result in disciplinary action. Clubs reserve the right to decline future events from the offending party in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 11, Section 15 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- **Pick Up After Your Dog**, by signing your entry form you agree to abide by all AKC rules, procedure, and regulations. This applies to picking up after your dog as well. Did you know that this could be a bench show offense that can result up to a \$500 fine and/or a 6 month suspension from ALL AKC Events.
- **Dogs Running Free** in accordance with AKC Tracking regulations, Chapter 1, Section 21, Due to the changing nature of the fields being used by clubs for tracking tests and the increased population at these sites by the general public. dogs must be "on lead" at all times on any area of the tracking site or show Premise. This will NOT apply to dogs owned or under the control of individuals not associated with the tracking test.
- Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Secretary will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agent of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. **Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging areas.**
- The Club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.
- All trophies must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed.
- Owners are responsible for filling out the entry form correctly, there will be no refunds for any errors in falling-out entry forms, no refund for duplicate entries.
- Entry Fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.
- No Entry Fee will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the Secretary or Show Committee.
- No Entry shall be made, and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to the acceptance. **Changes, Additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to the close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.**

- **Exhibitors Note:** Please notify Secretary of any change of address. Telephone entries and unsigned Entries Cannot Be Accepted. Entries Not on Official AKC Entry Form and Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE, Emailed acknowledgement of entries will be provided if an email address is included.
- **LOSS OR DAMAGE- Waiver of Rights.** The club reserves the right to remove any animal in distress from a parked vehicle or crate, and all persons attending these dog events hereby waive any claim for damages against the clubs for such removal. **PLEASE NOTE:** It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or their children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engaging in unsafe or disruptive behavior or whose equipment creates an impediment to the safe flow of traffic may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the event site. In such cases, no refund of any fee paid will be made. The clubs, state fairgrounds, show superintendent, their agent, employee, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss,, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitions, handler, or any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.
- **GNFA MECHANICAL EQUIPMENT POLICY**
- Skateboards, scooter, roller skates, hover boards, roller blades, and other similar mechanical equipment are prohibited within all property known as the Georgia National Fairgrounds & Agri-center. This policy will be strictly enforced.
- **UNLOADING/PARKING:** No driving on grass areas.
- **NO OVERNIGHT PARKING ALLOWED AT THE ARENA UNLESS YOU HAVE A RESERVED CAMPING SPOT.** Day parking of RVS allowed.
- Tent stakes may be used within/or on the Fairgrounds but must be approved by maintenance. This is to ensure you will not hit any utility lines.

PUPPIES UNDER FOUR (4) MONTHS ARE NOT ALLOWED on the Show Precincts or at any events associated with or held in conjunction with the DCA Specialty Show. The Show Event Committee has the authority to correct a violation of this AKC Rule.
