Special Performance Award – The Triathlete Challenge

If you and your dog are a multi-tasking team, set your sights on the Specialty Triathlete Challenge, a special award given to EACH Dalmatian/handler team that earns a qualifying leg or passing score in three (3) or more performance/companion venues during the National Specialty. The eligible events are: Tracking, Road Trial - CC/CCC, CCI/CCIC, RD/RDC, RDX classes; Agility—all titling classes; Obedience - all titling classes; Rally - all titling classes; Barn Hunt - all titling classes; Scent Work – all titling classes, Fast CAT, and Dock Diving. Only one score or performance in each venue will count towards this award, and the performance must be at the titling level, although the dog/handler team may already have earned the relevant title. If your dog can hock, heel, sniff, run, or jump, just pick your venues and go for the challenge!

Triathlete Forms must be turned in before 7 pm on June 19. All awards must be picked up at the Performance Breakfast. NO AWARDS WILL BE MAILED.

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

Certification: A written statement must accompany each TD entry for any dog that has not previously passed an American Kennel Club TD or TDU Tracking Test. The statement must be dated within two years of the date the test is to be held, signed by a person approved by the AKC to judge Tracking Tests or by a person/evaluator who has handled a dog to a TDX or VST title within the last ten (10) years, and must certify that the dog has satisfactorily performed a certification test.

Entry limitations: The Tracking Dog Test will be limited to 6 dogs. If the limit is not reached in Dalmatians, other breeds (including All Americans) may enter using the following procedure: Draw (1) Dalmatians without a TD Title, Draw (2) Dalmatians with a TD Title, Draw (3) Other breeds (including All Americans) without a TD Title, Draw (4) Other breeds (including All Americans) with a TD Title.

Dogs must be six months of age or older.

Entries must be on an official AKC entry form & will not be accepted without fees & signature & a statement of certification, if applicable.

Drawing of Entries for TD Test: A drawing will be held at 8:00 pm on May 15, 2025, at the home of the Test Secretary. The drawing shall be completely random among all Dalmatian entries received without a title followed by Dalmatians with a Title. Any remaining tracks will be filled by other breeds (including All Americans) without a title followed by other breeds (including All Americans) with a title in accordance with Chapter 1, Section 17b of the Tracking Regulations. When the limits have been drawn for all Dalmatian TD, all remaining entries shall be assigned to a position on an alternate list corresponding to the order in which they were drawn. The Test Secretary will notify all entrants of the results of the draw by email within 24 hours after the draw. Upon notification, alternates shall have the option of accepting or refusing the opportunity to be placed on the alternate list. **Please include your email address!**

Drawing for Tracks: The Judges will assemble the participants at the Vogelsang Park parking lot for a drawing by lot for the track number of each participant. The time for the draw will be stated in the Judging Program which will be emailed to the participants. The order in which tracks are run and the number of each track shall be determined by the Tracking Judges. Entrants & alternates must be present at this drawing to guarantee their position in the test. The first track for each event will be run as soon thereafter as it has aged the proper length of time. In the event of absentees among the confirmed entries, the next alternate, in drawing order who is present, will be allowed to fill the vacancy.

Refunds: No entry fee will be refunded, except the entry fee of a non-participating alternate. Or in the event an accepted entry cancels after the closing date & the Secretary is able to replace the entry from the alternate list. The entry fees will be refunded within seven days following the Test.

Bitches in season: Tracking Regulations Chapter 2, Section 8. Bitches in season may participate. The Test Secretary & judges are to be notified prior to the drawing for running order the day of the test. The last track(s) to be laid shall be reserved for the bitch(es) in season. If there is more than one bitch in season, a second draw for these bitches will be held.

DOGS RUNNING FREE In accordance with AKC Tracking regulations, Chapter 1, Section 21, Due to the changing nature of the fields being used by clubs for tracking tests and the increased population at these sites by the general public, dogs must be "on lead" at all times on any area of the tracking site. This will not apply to dogs owned or under the control of individuals not associated with the tracking test.

Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendents/Secretaries will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. **Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging areas.**

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. Fees must be paid in guaranteed funds. The Secretary will add a \$25 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent

returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis. Owners are responsible for errors in filling out entry forms; no refund for duplicate entries or errors on entry blanks.

Entry Fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.

Changes, Additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

EXHIBITORS NOTE: Please notify Secretary of any change of address. Telephone Entries and Unsigned Entries Cannot Be Accepted. Entries Not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. Emailed acknowledgement of entries will be provided IF an email address is included.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

ATTENTION ALL EVENT EXHIBITORS

- All dogs must be kept on leash except when being judged in off-leash events such as Agility, Barn Hunt, Fast CAT, Obedience, Rally, Road Trial, and/or Scent Work.
- At no time can dogs be tied out or otherwise left attached to anything other than a human when outside a crate, car, or other secure enclosed confinement. Leashes cannot be left dangling or dragging. Standing or stepping on a leash is not allowed as a form of restraint (but may be used in an emergency to help secure a loose dog.) Accommodations to this rule may be made for differently-abled handlers as determined by the Club.
- The show site will be made available to exhibitors, SUNDAY, JUNE 15, 2025. **The Great Hall is NOT AVAILABLE to EXHIBITORS BEFORE 4PM.**
- No unentered dogs or puppies allowed in building per AKC guidelines.
- No working (practice) in rings before or after show hours. Dogs are allowed in rings only during judging hours and scheduled practice times.
- No washing of animal food containers in restrooms. Bathing of dogs limited to bathing area in the Service Center. **NOTE: The Service Center restrooms, showers and dog bathing area will be UNAVAILABLE from 10AM-3PM on Monday and Tuesday.**
- Pick up after your dogs and dispose in provided receptacles.
- **No videotaping or photography during the events for resale is permitted without the Dalmatian Club of America, Inc. approval.**

- **Please be advised:** when an exhibitor/handler brings a dog to the podium for a win/placement photo they are establishing a de facto contract with the show photographer to purchase that photo.
- **No baby strollers are allowed in the show site or adjacent hallways during show hours.**
- Unless otherwise specified, all trophies and awards must be claimed the day of the show. **None will be mailed.** The club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.
- **VACCINATIONS:** Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- **Waiver of Rights** Any dog found in an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way (for example - left unattended on a grooming table in a noose not attached to a safety release clip; left in a vehicle without proper ventilation) will be removed. Exposing a dog to an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way is considered mistreatment. All persons attending this show hereby waive any claim for damages against the host clubs in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or improperly vented conditions.
- The club reserves the right to remove any animal in distress from a parked vehicle or crate, and all persons attending these dog events hereby waive any claim for damages against the clubs for such removal.
- **PLEASE NOTE: It is expressly understood that exhibitors or spectators alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor or spectator whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior or whose equipment creates an impediment to the safe flow of traffic may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the event site. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made.**
- **LIABILITY. The show-giving clubs, their members, Nestle-Purina, show superintendent, trial secretaries, their agents, employees, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children & further expect exhibitors and spectators to keep their children and dogs under strict control.**

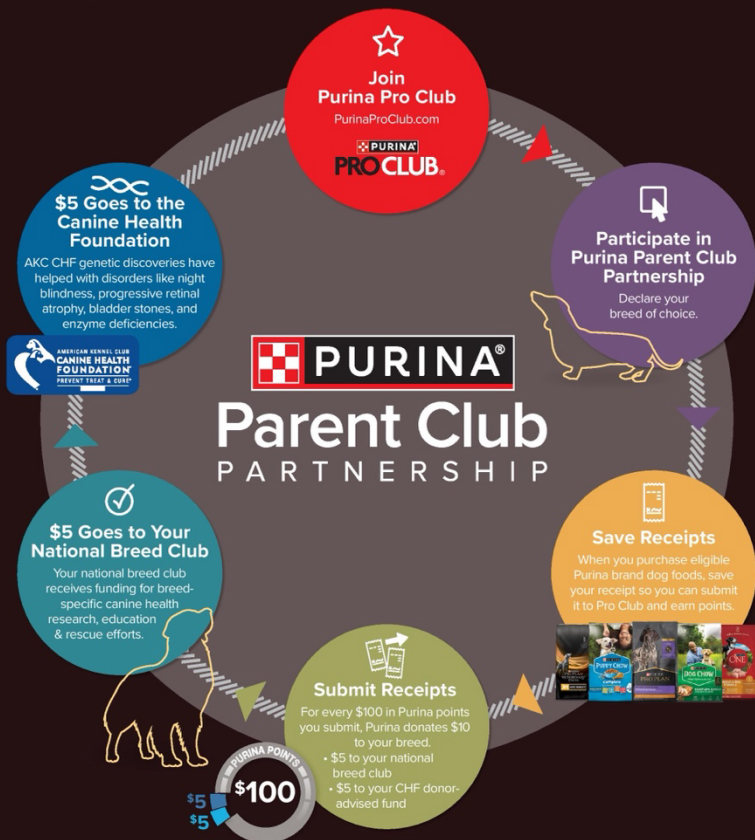

AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.
