Trial will be held rain or shine. Judging will commence at 10:00 AM on Saturday, October 3, 2026 and at 8:00 AM on Sunday, October 4, 2026. A dog may be entered in only 1 distance class at any Road Trial. Carriage drivers may only drive for 1 distance team (including themselves). Passenger exhibitors may only handle one distance team. Mounted exhibitors may only ride/participate on 1 distance team. All obedience exercises will be on a gravel road. All trails are suitable for mounted riders. Carriage drivers will have to make individual decisions on the suitability of trails.

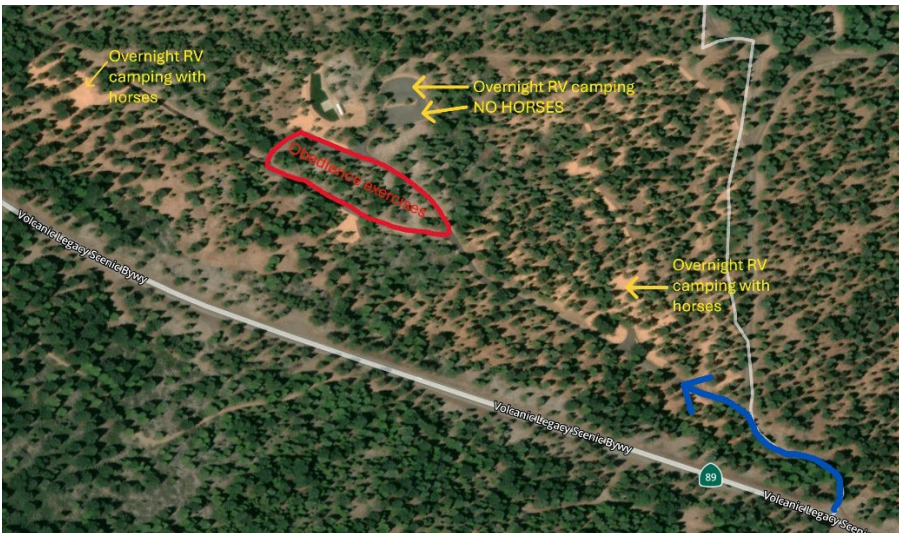
DIRECTIONS TO ROAD TRIAL:

From I-5 North and South take exit 736 to CA-89 South. Merge onto CA-89 South.
Go 3.1 miles and turn left onto the dirt road, see below. GPS coordinates: 41.2723, -122.2486.



Once on the dirt road take the first left.

Take the first right for overnight dry camping with horses and horse stabling.
Take the second right and park in the parking lot for overnight dry camping without horses.

ROAD TRIAL SITE RULES:

Garbage - Pack it in and pack it out.

If possible, keep food and garbage locked inside your trailer or vehicle to mitigate wildlife issues.

Non-Potable Water is provided for animal use.

Please Clean up manure from all areas and dump manure in designated areas only.

Dog poop should go in baggies in the garbage can. **Do not dispose of dog poop in the horse manure pile.**

Fill holes or repair excessive wear caused by horses (in pens, on highlines, as well as around client-provided portable corrals and trailers)

Highline only to designated trees.

No horses tied to a tree or from a high line within 12 feet of any tree.

Portable corrals may be used only in designated areas.

Dogs are allowed but must be contained to the immediate camping area, cleaned up after, and kept under voice control while on the trail.

Check-in time: 2 PM

Check-out time is 12 PM

Be respectful of the noise level after 10 PM

Fires may be permitted in designated fire rings only, and may be restricted during high fire season. All fires must be completely extinguished with water after each use.

Observe speed limit signs while on the property.

ROAD TRIAL PRIZES & AWARDS (Regular and optional titling classes)

Unless otherwise indicated, all prizes are offered by the Dalmatian Club of Northern California. The Dalmatian Club of Northern California offers rosettes for High Scoring Dog in Road Trial, New Titles earned at this trial, First, Second, Third and Fourth class placements and qualifying scores. Trophies not awarded become the property of Dalmatian Club of Northern California.

PRIZES (Open to Dalmatians only)

HIGH SCORING DOG IN ROAD TRIAL – Rosette and pottery

FIRST IN EACH CLASS – Blue rosette

SECOND IN EACH CLASS – Red rosette

THIRD IN EACH CLASS – Yellow rosette

FOURTH IN EACH CLASS – White rosette

QUALIFYING – Green rosette

Special Awards (non-regular Instinct class and non-Dalmatians)

A DCNC certificate of completion and a green qualifying rosette will be awarded to teams that complete the non-regular Instinct class or complete any of the regular or optional titling classes with a non-Dalmatian.

The Dalmatian Club of America does not award titles or certificates for Non-Regular classes.

TRIAL INFORMATION

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

As used in these Regulations, the word "dog" refers to either sex but only to Dalmatians that are purebred and eligible for registration in the American Kennel Club studbook or an AKC limited registration. An eligible unregistered dog for which the American Kennel Club has issued a PAL (ILP) number may also be entered. Any dog that is registered in the official registry of another country as a purebred Dalmatian may also be entered in a Dalmatian Club of America Road Trial. All Dalmatians entered in a Dalmatian Club of America Road Trial as described in these Regulations will be eligible for any prizes or titles offered at said trial. Non-Dalmatians are eligible to enter Non-Regular classes only. The DCA does not award titles or certificates to Non-Dalmatians, but awards may be offered by the Host Club.

CLASSES OFFERED

REGULAR & OPTIONAL TITLING CLASSES:

COACHING CERTIFICATE (mounted or carriage): Open to purebred Dalmatians not less than six months of age, regardless of previous titles earned, as described in the Road Trial Regulations, Chapter 7, Section 1.

COACHING COMPANION NOVICE (mounted or carriage – 3 miles): Open to purebred Dalmatians not less than 12 months of age regardless of previous titles earned. There is no A or B class distinction.

COACHING COMPANION INTERMEDIATE (mounted or carriage – 6 miles): Open to purebred Dalmatians not less than 12 months of age regardless of previous titles earned. There is no A or B class distinction.

ROAD DOG CLASSES (mounted or carriage – 12.5 miles):

ROAD DOG – A (mounted or carriage): Open to any Dalmatian not less than 12 months of age on the day of the Trial that has not yet earned the Road Dog Title (mounted or carriage) & is being handled by an exhibitor who has not previously qualified any dog for the RD or RDC title at any Road Trial.

ROAD DOG – B (mounted or carriage): Open to any Dalmatian not less than 12 months of age on the day of the Trial that: 1) has already earned the title RD, RDC, RDX or RDXC, and/or 2) is being handled by an exhibitor who has previously qualified a dog for the RD, RDC, RDX, or RDXC title. A dog that has previously earned an RD, RDC, RDX, or RDXC may continue to compete in this class, but only if all available time slots have not already been filled with dogs that have not yet earned an RD or RDC title.

ROAD DOG EXCELLENT CLASSES (mounted or carriage – 25 miles):

ROAD DOG EXCELLENT – A (mounted or carriage): Open to any Dalmatian not less than 18 months of age on the day of the Trial that has earned the title RD or RDC, but has not yet earned the title RDX or RDXC, and is being handled by an exhibitor who has not previously qualified any dog for the RDX or RDXC title.

ROAD DOG EXCELLENT – B (mounted or carriage): Open to any Dalmatian not less than 18 months of age on the day of the Trial that has earned the title RD or RDC and 1) has already earned the title RDX or RDXC and/or 2) is being handled by an exhibitor who has previously qualified a dog for the RDX or RDXC title. A dog that has previously earned an RDX or RDXC may continue to compete in this class, but only if all available time slots have not already been filled with dogs that have not yet earned an RDX or RDXC title.

ADDITIONAL NON-REGULAR CLASSES:

INSTINCT (mounted or carriage) *The Dalmatian Club of America does not award titles for Non-Regular Classes; however, the Dalmatian Club of Northern California will offer a certificate of completion and a green qualifying rosette:* Open to purebred Dalmatians and non-Dalmatians not less than six months of age. The class will be identical to the coaching certificate (mounted or carriage) class as described in the Road Trial Regulations, Chapter 7, Section 1 **except dogs will remain on leash for all exercises.**

NON-DALMATIAN CLASSES (mounted or carriage) *The Dalmatian Club of America does not award titles for Non-Regular Classes; however, the Dalmatian Club of Northern California will offer a certificate of completion and a green qualifying rosette:* The Coaching Certificate, Coaching Companion Novice, Coaching Companion Intermediate, Road Dog (no A or B class distinction), and Road Dog Excellent (no A or B class distinction) as described above will be offered to non-Dalmatian dogs.

GENERAL INFORMATION & ROAD TRIAL RULES ROAD TRIAL ENTRY FEES

A dog may be entered in only 1 distance class at any Road Trial. Carriage drivers may only drive for 1 distance team (including themselves). Passenger exhibitors may only handle one distance team. Mounted exhibitors may only ride/participate on 1 distance team.

ALL OBEDIENCE EXERCISES WILL BE JUDGED ON A GRAVEL ROAD.

First Dog per team entered in any distance class: \$90.00

Each additional dog entered on the same team in any distance class (maximum of 3 dogs per team): \$40.00

Coaching Certificate/Coaching Certificate Carriage: \$60.00

Carriage rental (non-distance classes): \$60.00

Non-Regular Instinct class: \$40.00

Non-Regular Non-Dalmatian Coaching Certificate (mounted or carriage): \$60.00

Non-Regular Non-Dalmatian distance class: \$90.00

HORSE RENTAL/BOARDING INFORMATION

Please contact Deanna Hayden as soon as possible if you are in need of a distance carriage cart and horse rental.

A limited number of private mounted rental horses are available. Please contact Deanna Hayden as soon as possible to be connected with the owner of a private rental horse. Fees for the rental horse will be negotiated between the competitor and the horse owner. The competitor will be responsible for paying for and assisting and/or making boarding arrangements for the rental horse and lodging arrangements for the horse's owner(s).

Riders will be encouraged to pair up for the trial portion of the competition for safety reasons. Also, due to the rugged nature of the trails, competitors are highly encouraged to have either boots or shoes on their horses.

Please be very honest about your riding experience when you reserve your horse. The Dalmatian Club of America, Inc. & the Dalmatian Club of Northern California do not contract with any supplier of rental horses & therefore makes no claim, warranty or assertions as to the safety or suitability of any rental horse. Riders that choose to rent a horse for the purpose of participation at any DCA Road Trial do so at their own risk. Riders are strongly encouraged to clarify & understand any terms of liability required by the supplier prior to the rental of any horse.

NOTE: The State of California does not have an Equine Activity Liability Act (EALA).

Persons needing to board their horses will need to personally contact: Ruth Altes at vsequine@gmail.com to make boarding arrangements. Boarding fees are \$20.00 per day. Exhibitor supplies own feed, water, and shavings for stall bedding & cleans stall/area before leaving. Trailer parking is available at no extra cost.

NOTE: Horses brought onto Iron Horse Unlimited or Table Rock must have a current negative Coggins test less than 6 months (on date of arrival to stables) & health Certificate less than 20 days old (on date of arrival to stables). No Exceptions.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- No videotaping or photography during the events for resale is permitted without Dalmatian Club of Northern California approval.
- Please be advised: When exhibitors/handlers bring a dog to the podium for a win/placement photo, they are establishing a de facto contract with the show photographer to purchase that photo.
- Acknowledgements of entries will be made as soon as possible after entries have closed. Should such acknowledgement not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please notify the Road Trial Secretary at deannadhk@icloud.com
- TO BE ACCEPTABLE an entry must be submitted with required entry fee on an Official Road Trial Entry Form.
- ENTRY FORM CHANGES, additions, correction & cancellations must be received in writing prior to the closing of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.
- THE ROAD TRIAL-GIVING CLUB, the Road Trial Secretary, and the landowners assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by the exhibitors, handlers or to any of their dogs or property.
- THE ROAD TRIAL-GIVING CLUB assumes no responsibility for the welfare of children & further expects exhibitors & spectators to keep their children under strict control.
- THE ROAD TRIAL COMMITTEE & THE DALMATIAN CLUB OF AMERICA, INC. AND THE EVENT COMMITTEE may make & enforce any rules they deem necessary to ensure the continuity of the Road Trial & the goodwill of the land owner. Any disciplinary event hearing, rule violation, complaint or charges will be resolved by the Dalmatian Club of America, Inc. Show Event Committee. The Show Event Committee members are Deanna Hayden, Winter & Joe Pearsall, Deborah & Amber Cardin, Dawn Mael, or any other DCNC club member on the grounds during the event and DCA board member Sam Kovitz.
- There will be no refund for duplicate entries.
- The Club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.
- No entry fees will be refunded if the Trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the Road Trial Secretary.
- ROAD TRIAL REGULATIONS: All competitors in the Road Trial will be required to read, voluntarily agree & sign a statement of release & waiver of liability prior to participation. Release forms will be available at the registration table at the Road Trial check-in. Exhibitors are responsible for reading & being familiar with them.
- No entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.
- The DCA, the Trial Chairman & the Trial Secretary assume no responsibility for correctness or incomplete information given on the entry form.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified by the judge, or barred from competition by action of the Road Trial Chair or Secretary or because it had been entered incorrectly.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Secretary will add a collection fee of \$25 to the amount of each returned check.
- Refunds for cancellations due to overpayments or cancellations made prior to the close of entries will be processed after the trial.
- No dogs will be allowed in the Road Trial judging area except those entered in the Road Trial or being used in an official capacity as designated by the Trial Event Committee.
- No un-entered dogs will be allowed on the trails. Un-entered dogs must be crated in the area designated by the Trial Event Committee.
- The DCA & the Trial Chairman are not responsible to furnish any service to notify or summon exhibitors who are late for assigned judging. Exhibitors alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs at the start point at their assigned time. Judges will not wait for an exhibitor holding up a class but may judge the exhibit at a later time at their discretion.
- Appropriate riding attire, including ASTM Certified Helmets & riding boots or shoes with at least 1/2 inch heel are required.
- The Trial Committee reserves the right to determine a rider's ability before allowing him/her to compete in the road trial. Should it be determined that a rider might present a safety hazard to himself, his horse or the dogs he/she may be excluded from competition. In this case, the entry fee will be refunded.
- Maps of the course will be available. This course is suitable for mounted exhibitors. Driving competitors are responsible for assessing the course & making the decision as to whether or not the course is suitable for driving.
- THERE IS AN INHERENT RISK TO ANY EQUINE ACTIVITY. Exhibitors acknowledge that risk & assume all liability for themselves, their animals & their belongings upon signing the entry form.

AGREEMENT

I (we) acknowledge that the "Dalmatian Road Trial Regulations" have been made available to me (us) and that I am (we are) familiar with their contents.

I (we) waive any and all claims, causes of action,

I (we) might otherwise have against DCA and any DCA approved judge, judging at this event, under DCA Rules, Regulations and Guide- lines.

I (we) agree that the club holding this Dalmatian Road Trial has the right to refuse entry for cause, which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the Dalmatian Road Trial and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prize money, ribbons or trophies,

I (we) agree to hold this club, its member, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendent or show secretary and the owner or lessor of the show premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly and/or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the Dalmatian Road Trial premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and

I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and

I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death or damage or injury, to be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person or any other cause or causes.

I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by a person including myself (ourselves) on or account of damage to property arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this Dalmatian Road Trial, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused, or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other person.

A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time the entries for a show closed. If the registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquirement regardless of whether or not the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been made to AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 14, Section 3).
